

ExportSuite

Brief Description

The ExportSuite greatly expands the export functionality and transfer capabilities of scan orders from BCS-2® while still allowing for the greatest possible configuration flexibility.

So called transfer targets replace the target directory and target filename of a certain order type. This transfer target then determines the file type to be created (PDF, single images, etc.) and the selected method of transfer (file system, FTP, etc.). By defining multiple transfer targets it is possible to launch multiple, quasi-simultaneous actions which will be carried out on an order with only one click (e.g. rotating all images of an order upon transfer). Additionally, meta text files which contain order indexes, page indexes, etc., can be created with the ExportSuite. External applications can also be started with the Suite and additional export possibilities used.

Put simply: with the ExportSuite you can control what will happen with a scan order when it is transferred.

Areas of Application and Functions

- Export of scan orders according to individual preferences
- Freely configurable connections to third-party systems such as the MyBib eRoom, CONTENTdm, etc. as well as export for the DFG-Viewer.
- Flexible definition capabilities of transfer targets via an action list which is carried out when an order is transferred
- Creation of meta text files like METS-XML, XML, HTML, TXT, etc.
- Launching external applications during or after order transfer
- Transfer of images, OCR texts as well as meta text files to multiple targets with multiple settings with only one click
- Implicit creation of backup files when transferring orders
- Retention of the original images of orders through virtual page-splitting / masking; double pages in a single image are only split upon order transfer
- Image processing such as deskew, invert, rotate, etc. upon order transfer
- Transfer target types and transfer channels can be defined and combined as desired

Transfer Target Types

- Transfer of images (JPEG, TIFF, etc.)
- PDF creation (PDF, PDF/A, searchable PDF)
- Multi-page TIFF creation
- ZIP archive creation
- Meta text file creation
- External application launching
- Sending of HTTP requests

Channels of Delivery

- File system (local or network drives)
- FTP
- SFTP
- Email via SMTP server
